In 2021, our verse for the year was Matthew 9:37-38, “The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore, pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.” In 2022, it was Matthew 21:13. Jesus said, “My house shall be called a house of prayer.” In 2023, it was Luke 6:46, “But why do you call Me ‘Lord, Lord,’ and not do the things which I say?” In 2024, it was Psalm 118:24, “This is the day the LORD has made; we will rejoice and be glad in it.” In 2025, it was James 1:22, “But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.”

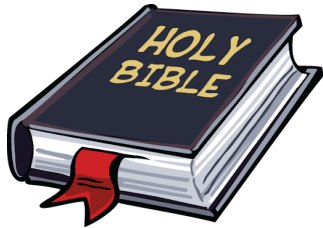
Philippians 4:6-7

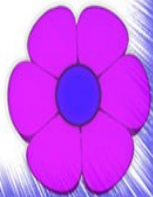
